Chief & Council of Washaw Sibi's Focus

As reported at last year's AGA, our focus is on securing a site for our future village.....our future home.

As we explained last year, in order to move forward we need to secure commitments from the other Cree communities of Eeyou Istchee to transfer 1 square kilometer of their Category I lands to Washaw Sibi.

This has been our focus over this last year, and today we would like to show the progress we have made.

We will have more to report early in the Fall when we have our AGA.

IF EACH OF THE 9 CREE COMMUNITIES COMMITS TO TRANSFER TO WASHAW SIBI 1 SQUARE KILOMETER OF THEIR CATEGORY I LANDS WE COULD ACHIEVE OUR OBJECTIVE.

SECURING THIS COMMITMENT HAS BEEN OUR FOCUS.

WHAT HAS BEEN OUR STRATEGY?

Changes to the boundaries of the land regime of the Cree communities requires the consent of the community members of each community.

We would like the members of each Cree community to deliberate over our request for 1 square kilometer of Category I land to help us have a Cree home.

So we began by meeting the Councils of each of the Cree communities to request an opportunity to present our request at their next AGA's.

We are happy to report that we were very well received by each Cree community Council and they expressed their support.
